**Knights of Columbus cross state lines for a common cause** - North Conway NH Council 7575 and Bridgton, Maine Council 11376 have proven that crossing state lines is not a barrier in providing a much needed service to the Mother Seton House located in Fryeburg, Maine. Mother Seton House founded in 2007, is a nonprofit faith based organization giving support to pregnant mothers, new mothers and infants in need. The program serves communities in both Maine and New Hampshire. In the spring of 2011 Mother Seton House signed an agreement to purchase a house in Fryeburg, Maine where pregnant women, mothers and their infants may reside while developing skills and resources for independence. The house was in need of extensive modifications. It was at that point in time when the two councils joined forces to begin the task of renovating the house. This has been a work in progress that has taken place throughout the year requiring both councils to work in tandem with each other. The expected completion date is 2012.

**Contributions and Tax Requirements** - Parishioners who itemize deductions for income tax purposes must have bank records or receipts from the parish in order to deduct contributions to the parish on their tax return. In order for the parish to be able to provide a parishioner with the required receipt, parishioners are encouraged to use parish envelopes. The use of the envelopes is the only manner which provides the parish with the information needed to provide a receipt to a parishioner. As an alternative, using a check or an automatic withdrawal from one's bank account to make weekly contributions will provide the parishioner with required documentation to support the deduction. A parishioner directly placing cash in the weekly offertory basket will no longer be able to legally deduct the contribution for tax purposes. **OLM Music Ministry** – It has been said that “To sing is to pray twice!” This very visible ministry enhances our community prayers so meaningfully! Cantors, singers, and musicians contribute time and talent as needed to celebrate the OLM Masses. Currently many opportunities exist for cantors, choir members, and instrumentalists because seasonal changes, vacations and health issues have thinned our ranks.

What is your musical gift? Consider one of the following roles: **Choir** – singers who attend 2 or more practices for a specific holy day or special liturgy during the year. Rehearsals are planned for Thursday evenings. Special accommodations can be made for part-time valley residents. Main qualification is the ability to blend while singing in parts. (It is helpful but not necessary to read music.) **Cantor** – confident singers who after singing beside seasoned cantors gradually lead music at weekend liturgies on a scheduled basis. A rehearsal during the week is required prior to the Mass. **Musicians** – who have some expertise with trumpet, flute, violin, oboe or keyboard to accompany at special liturgies. **Sound mixer** – who listens for acoustical and technical balance during choir sessions.
