**Anointing of the Sick** - As you know, for about three years, we have celebrated this wonderful Sacrament every 1st weekend of the month, rotating between either after the Saturday liturgy or the last Mass of Sunday. **This weekend, the Sacrament of the Sick will be administered following the 10:30 a.m. Mass in the Family Room, next to the Vesting Sacristy.** You've no doubt seen many people lined-up to receive the Sacrament on such weekends. It is a powerful celebration! Please help us to keep a prayerful silence while people prepare themselves while waiting, rather than socializing with them in the Narthex. The Sacrament is primarily intended for parishioners or visitors who will be going through upcoming medical tests, diagnoses, on-going treatment regimens, arthritic & mobility ailments, or going through recuperative O.T. & P.T. Children who are also baptized, are welcome to be anointed in the event of future treatment regimens, surgery, testing, etc. We ask all that who are preparing to receive the Sacrament enter the room alone or accompanied by spouse, friend or parent, close the door behind you, refrain from conversation with the priest-celebrant, to maintain a prayerful silence, other than to briefly state what you would like him to prepare for, if you wish to do so, for example, "Father, I am having a biopsy done on Tuesday." That is sufficient. If you need a wheelchair while waiting, see one of the ushers before Mass. There is also a bench nearby and comfortable seating in the Narthex and in the Family Room. You don't have to kneel and there is no need to say anything. Finally, should you see someone standing in line that you know, please be respectful of their right to privacy, not asking them for information or by telling others who is there. Thanks so much. Let us pray daily for the sick among us!

Again, we thank everyone here for making this very important fund raiser such a success.
